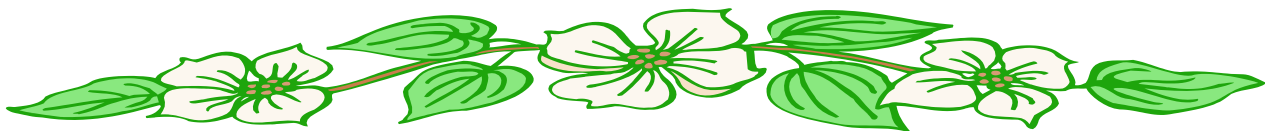


FROM MRS LORD

Love Indi.

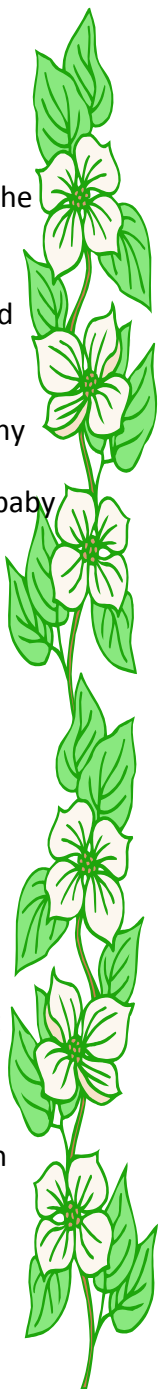
Dear Bunya,
