LEADERS REPORT

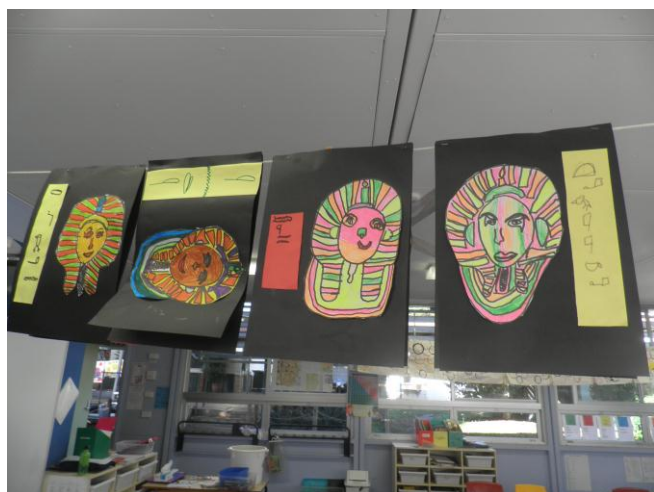
